Between August and December, the Development Program works with each team on the fundamentals of the game, including dynamic skating that focuses on proper stride, edgework, and quicker feet. We offer to all teams in our organization approximately 14-15 sessions (subject to team schedules) with Development Group. The cost for this program is included with your registration.
